Thank you for your request of 27 October 2021, under the Official Information Act (the Act) to Kāinga Ora – Homes and Communities, asking for:

- All new homes delivered by Kāinga Ora, broken down by State / Community Group Housing / Transitional housing / KiwiBuild
- Location Tauranga City Territorial Local Authority (TLA)
- Date range Since 1 January 2018, up to end of September 2021 (provided by financial year / part financial year (2021/22 to date))
- By typology (standalone, duplexes, apartments etc.)
- How many of these homes are currently occupied.

The following table provides the information requested. All of these homes are currently occupied.

There are currently 233 Kāinga Ora state homes in the Tauranga TLA (as at 30 September 2021).

In April 2017, Kāinga Ora (then Housing New Zealand) transferred 1,138 homes to Accessible Properties, which continue to be used to house low-income households.

Kāinga Ora intends to deliver 53 new state homes in Tauranga by 2023. This includes 21 homes planned for Haukore Street and eight for Waihi Road, where older homes on

existing sites will be relocated or demolished to allow a larger number of new, warm and dry homes to be built.

Kāinga Ora is working hard to deliver more public housing for whānau in the city, recognising the pressing need for more housing for people to live in. A range of options around increasing housing supply are actively being pursued, including, partnering with other land owners, and purchase of land.
