Thank you for your request dated 4 November 2022 under the Official Information Act 1992 (the Act) for the following information:

The total number of 1-bedroom units currently available in Hamilton.

Note: This is the total number of properties Kāinga Ora owns and manages.

 The total number of current tenants on Kainga Ora's BIT register who currently live in Hamilton and who are also seeking a 1-bedroom unit in Hamilton.

 The total number of those tenants (on Kainga Ora's BIT register who currently live in Hamilton and are also seeking a 1-bedroom unit in Hamilton) that Kainga Ora considers as having a higher priority than Mr Handy.

Current tenants may be required by Kāinga Ora to transfer to another Kāinga Ora property because their existing property is required for business reasons, including their current home being redeveloped, undergoing major repair or a lease expiring on homes not owned by Kāinga Ora. It can also be for a household underutilising or seriously overcrowding a property. Transfers for other reasons are made through the Ministry of Social Development (MSD).

Vacant properties are checked against the Business Initiated Transfer (BIT) register before they are considered for applicants on the MSD waitlist.

There is no priority rating applied to BIT transfers, so this part of your request is being refused under section 18(g) of the Act as the information is not held and not believed to be held by another agency.
