GENERAL

Colour Choices: Select one wall paint colour, one door paint colour, one vinyl, and one carpet option to be used consistently throughout.

New kitchens: joinery must be white melamine, dry area benchtops are high pressure laminate with a neutral finish, wet area benches are stainless steel with upstand.

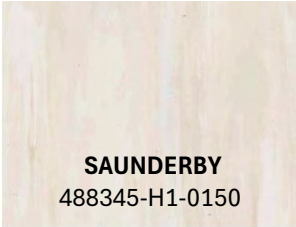
All ceilings: must be white. | **Maintenance:** when doors require painting, match to the existing colour.

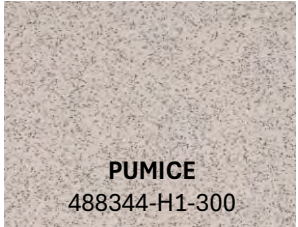

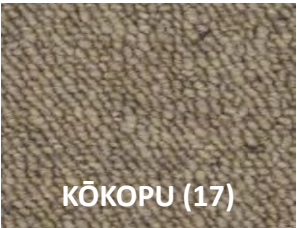
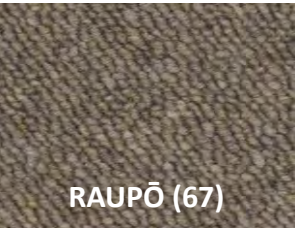

CARPET - WOOL

BREMWORTH | RANGE: WAINAMU CARPET (PRODUCT # 1506)



New homes and Retrofit Programme: Wool carpet must be used.

Existing homes: Allow for like-for-like replacement (nylon with nylon and wool with wool).

Where all carpet throughout the home requires replacement, or where no carpet has been previously installed, wool carpet must be selected.
