

- 2. Existing properties purchased by Kainga Ora over the previous 3 years; and
- 3. New leases signed by Kainga Ora with private owners for residential properties."

Most of the state houses in Tauranga (1,138) were transferred to Accessible Properties on 1 April 2017. As at 30 April 2020, there were 229 state homes in the Tauranga Territorial Local Authority (TLA).

Kāinga Ora purchases newly built homes from developers and builders. These are purchased either before construction starts, during construction, or once construction is complete. This also includes newly built properties available to the market. These homes have not been lived in before.

Kāinga Ora will also meet housing need by purchasing existing homes that have previously been occupied, usually built after 2000 and that meet a required standard of condition, insulation and amenity. These are purchased through the standard sale and purchase agreement.

Kāinga Ora also leases existing or newly built properties to provide homes.

The information below (Attachment 1) is for the Tauranga TLA. Kāinga Ora – Homes and Communities does not hold information by electorate boundaries. All the homes in Attachment 1 are purchased homes.
