Thank you for your email of 21 September 2021 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

A list of all the pensioner's complexes in New Zealand. Who the complex is operated by.

I am refusing your request under section 18(g) of the Act as this information is not held by Kāinga Ora and I have no reason for believing it is held by another organisation.

For context, Kāinga Ora does have a number of units and houses across New Zealand that are set aside for our residents who are over 60 years of age. These units are often included in larger complexes or interspersed with families and individual residents who are not aged over 60. As such, it is not possible to extract an accurate list of properties that are exclusively reserved for our older residents.

It may interest you to know that we do have developments underway, such as the Highbury Triangle Development in Auckland, which will predominately be made up of a state housing complex for older people, alongside a component of market homes and commercial space.
